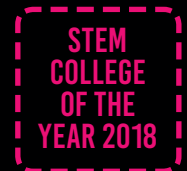


How we support our students to achieve their potential

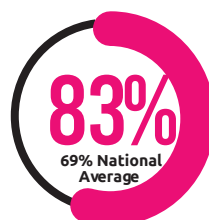
