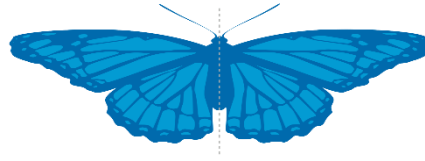


## SYMMETRY ACTIVITY



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You will need:

Paper

A Pencil

Coloured Pencils

A Ruler

A Camera

Your task:

Find as many things in your HOME and GARDEN that have LINES OF SYMMETRY. **Photograph** these objects so that the lines of symmetry can clearly be seen. If you can, print some of these out and stick on a piece of paper with the title: 'Objects with lines of symmetry.'



Use your paper, pencils and ruler to **draw selected objects from your home or garden, which have lines of symmetry. Mark the lines of symmetry clearly with a ruler.** Take your time and try to do a good job. If you don't feel confident drawing, choose simple objects to copy, for example a plate or a plant pot. Title your drawings 'Symmetry in my home.'
