If you hope to apply for a reduced fee please do so in person.
- * If you wish to pay by debit or credit card you will need to use a payment details form which is downloadable from the website.

If you are studying at any of our Exeter College sites, you will need to wear your photo ID badge whilst on college premises. You will need to collect the badge in person as it will also contain your log in details for any online materials and resources for your course. Badges can be obtained from a learning centre approximately one week after your enrolment.


